

State Energy/Heating Assistance Program Access and Application

The state has established the Home Energy Plus Program to assist families meet the rising costs of home heating that have accompanied the extreme winter temperatures and spikes in propane costs. The process by which homeowners and families can access this program is as follows:

- 1) Program application must be filled out and turned in, either in person or by FAX. To print out the application, go to:

- Click on 'Grantee Information'
- Click on 'Home Energy Plus Information'
- Click on 'FFY14 Instructions'

Print and complete the application – it can be scanned and e-mailed back to Ashland County Health and Human Services or FAXed (the Town Hall has a FAX machine) or submitted in person.

First time applicants MUST provide a picture I.D. which suggests that turning in the application in person may be the preferable method of application.

There is also a Checklist online to ensure that all relevant information is supplied.

Processing of applications and availability of funds has been expedited in the face of the energy/heating crisis.

We encourage all homeowners or residents to take advantage of this program to assist in dealing with the spiking cost of home heating.
