Chapter 223

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Town Board of the Town of La Pointe 4-28-2006. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 223-1. Findings and authority.

- A. The Town, pursuant to § 62.23(2) and (3), Wis. Stats., is authorized to prepare and adopt a Comprehensive Plan as defined in § 66.1001(1)(a) and (2), Wis. Stats.
- B. The Town Board has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation and review of the Comprehensive Plan as required by § 66.1001(4)(a), Wis. Stats.
- C. The Town Board directed the Community and Public Works Planning (CAPP) Committee to develop a draft Comprehensive Plan.
- D. The Plan Commission has reviewed the draft Comprehensive Plan which consists of the background report and policy document and has, by a majority vote of the entire Commission recorded in the official minutes, adopted a resolution recommending to the Town Board the adoption of the Comprehensive Plan which contains all of the elements specified in § 66.1001(2), Wis. Stats.
- E. The Town Board has held at least one public hearing on this chapter, in compliance with the requirements of § 66.1001(4)(d), Wis. Stats.

§ 223-2. Adoption. ¹

The Town Board adopts the Comprehensive Plan, consisting of the background report and policy document, pursuant to § 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

§ 223-3. Documents incorporated by reference.

The Town Board incorporates the following documents by reference into the Comprehensive Plan as may be adopted and amended:

- A. Park and Recreation Plan.
- B. Trails Plan.
- C. Harbor Plan.
- D. Airport Layout Plan.

§ 223-4. When effective.

This chapter shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Town Board [as defined in § 59.001(2m), Wis. Stats.] and publication and posting as required by law.

- B. County Clerk for Ashland County;

- E. Wisconsin Land Council; and
- F. Department of Administration.
