## May - June 2019 Parks Report

### Downtown

- All public restrooms except for the Rec Center building were opened and operational by mid-May.
- New 1.8 gpf toilets were installed at the Joni's Beach public bathroom. An informational and safety conscious sign painted by Jeff Theune's class was put up along the beach.
- The last available Memorial Bench space in the Pocket Park was sold and the bench mounted by Memorial Day. A very large limb on the willow tree next to the porta potties began to peel off the trunk and had to be removed for sidewalk safety.
- The Rec Center will have three porta-potties along the north side of the building for the 2019 season, and I will be working on plan development for new public restrooms. Steve and I put together the new playground structure and will continue to work on landscaping, detailing, and constructing an ADA path along the tennis courts into July. Thanks to Evan Sr. and Evan Jr. for their help installing the play structure.

### BBTP

- The Park was opened, and all water turned on in early May, and the busy weekends began almost immediately. The in-line sediment filters installed last winter were an instant success, and the flush valves in the remote bathrooms have been operating without malfunction.
- The pit toilet drinking fountain/ foot wash remains closed until we can excavate and reroute the drain, which is completely full of sand.
- Letters were mailed and new stickers assigned to all NMV owners who have a spot on the new rack. An informational and safety awareness sign was installed on the beach.
- It's going to be a very busy summer at the Park, have fun and please be safe!
