

VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT SPRING PRIMARY ELECTION APRIL 7, 2020

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 10 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

YOU MUST MAKE A REQUEST FOR AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IN WRITING.

Contact your municipal clerk and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the election. You may also submit a written request by letter. Your written request must give:

1. Your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote
2. The address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different
3. The date of the election(s) for which you desire an absentee ballot
4. The date
5. Your signature.

Your request may be mailed, emailed, or delivered in person.

The deadline for making applications to vote absentee by mail is 5:00pm, on Thursday, April 2, 2020.

Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk.

Voting an absentee ballot in person

You can also personally go to the clerk's office and vote an absentee ballot.

THE MUNICIPAL CLERK WILL DELIVER VOTED BALLOTS RETURNED ON OR BEFORE ELECTION DAY TO THE PROPER POLLING PLACE BEFORE THE POLLS CLOSE ON APRIL 7, 2020. ANY BALLOTS RECEIVED AFTER THE POLLS CLOSE WILL **NOT** BE COUNTED.
