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SmithGroup reviewed the Letter provided by Madeline Island Ferry Line (MIFL) dated 05/29/2020 regarding their review of the project and project payments. The following includes the concerns by MIFL, responses from SmithGroup and background information. SmithGroup hopes this provides sufficient information to address MIFL's concerns.

MIFL Line Item #7 – Steel Pile Pinning - \$176,700.00:

There was no work done on this line item to our knowledge, however on pay request #1 a payment was made to Wren Works on this item in the amount of \$17,600.00 and the balance due for this item in the amount of \$159,030 is still appearing on the final pay request as a balance due for this item.

We believe the balance due on this item is \$0.00 and that the previously paid amount of \$17,600.00 should be deleted from the final payment to correct the earlier over payment for work not completed.

SmithGroup response:

During pile driving portion of the project several piles were not able to be driven to depth shown on project Contract Documents. This necessitated installation of the pile pinning at select locations per the Contract Documents. Pile pinning was installed during the week starting 4/11/2020. The full payment for this line item will be made in accordance with Contract Documents. Additional documentation, including photos are provided in Attachment 1.

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MIFL Line Item #14 - Mooring Dolphins - \$137,805.00:

There was no work done on this item, however on pay request #1 a payment was made to Wren Works on this item in the amount of \$42,625.14, which left a balance due for this item of \$95,179.86, which was accounted for in change Order #1, as it was deem that the owner was going to do this work themselves. However, the \$42,625.14 is still in question as we do not know why this amount was paid – if this amount was for the cost of materials for this line item, then the materials need to be delivered to the Town. If no materials are presented to account for this \$42,625.14 previous payment, then this amount will also need to be deleted for the final payment.

SmithGroup response:

During discussion regarding Change Order #1 Wren Works noted the following regarding the proposed change order to remove the Passenger Shelter and Mooring Dolphins from the contract:

- 1. In the bidding process, costs for equipment are spread over the entire project. Removing an entire line item does not eliminate the allocated cost of equipment.
- 2. Due to construction scheduling labor cost incurred are not eliminated by the removal of an entire line item.

During follow-on discussions with Wren Works regarding Change Order #1, Wren Works noted the following:

"Per the general conditions Article 10.03 and Article 11.03d; we are making a formal appeal in your recommendation to the Town that the deduction of the full unit price item for the mooring dolphins and shelter be used in change order 0001.

- 1. The items being removed from our contract but are NOT being removed from the project. "The Owner will install this separately".
 - a. Per 11.03d3: Additional expenses are incurred as a result of the elimination of the item as the prorated equipment cost of \$40,672.84 is still incurred.
 - b. Per 11.03d3: Labor expense of \$6,598.72 is still incurred as a result of the elimination of the item as the crew members are still required to be onsite.
 - c. Per 12.01c: The additional mark up of \$2,269.03 is reasonable contractors fee.
- 2. Wren Works requests the change order 001 be reduced to \$108,449.00 to cover the above expenses."

Based on these and follow on conversations and meetings with Wren Works regarding Change Order #1 the final sum of \$115,363.86 was agreed to. The \$42,625.14 is related to these discussions, Change Order #1 and a part of the Contract Documents.
