

**Madeline Island (LaPointe) Airport**  
**\_\_ANNUAL TIE-DOWN PERMIT\_\_**

The undersigned \_\_\_\_\_ hereby applies for a seasonal tie down permit at the Madeline Island (LaPointe) municipal airport, and if granted, promises compliance with reasonable rules established for users of the airport by the LaPointe Town Board. It is understood and accepted that the term of this permit shall be January 1<sup>st</sup>, \_\_\_\_\_ through December 31<sup>st</sup>, \_\_\_\_\_ and that this permit shall entitle the permit holder to tie down one (1) aircraft on a first come, first serve basis and that no tie down position shall be reserved.

The annual fee for this permit shall be set by the LaPointe Town Board and may be changed by them annually. Payment of this season's permit fee shall be in lieu of daily tie down fees. The lease payment made by tenants who have leased land for an aircraft hangar shall be in lieu of all tie down fees.

The season tie down fee set by the LaPointe Town Board is currently:

- A. Single Engine Aircraft**                      **\$221.55 (\$210.00 plus 5.5% sales tax)**
- B. Multi Engine Aircraft**                      **\$332.33 (\$315.00 plus 5.5% sales tax)**

It is further agreed that the permit holder shall fully insure the aircraft tied down at the airport under this permit for property damage and public liability insurance, and certifies the following coverage with \_\_\_\_\_ Insurance Company during the term of this permit in the amounts of:
