The custodian(s) of records for Ambulance is the Ambulance Director, Cindy Dalzell Administrative Officer

Public records are available for inspection at the La Pointe Town Hall at La Pointe, Wisconsin between 9:30 A.M. – 3:30 P.M. Monday through Friday except for holidays.

You should make your request in writing and state as clearly as possible which records you want. If your request is denied, you will receive a written reason for denial.

Any charge for a Public Information Request requires prepayment if over \$5.00.

There shall be no charge for locating a record unless the actual cost thereof exceeds \$50, in which case the cost shall be \$30 an hour in accordance with \$19.35(3). *Amended 2/14/2012*, *12/27/2016*

The cost of copying documents is \$0.33 per page, and this office shall demand prepayment if the total cost of copying exceeds \$5.00.

Wisconsin law provides, in part, that the authority having custody of the record may, at its option, permit the requester to photocopy the record or provide the requester with a copy substantially as readable as the original.

If you feel you have been wrongfully denied access to a public record, refer to the Public Records Statutes posted with this notice for possible remedies. Due to the length of this statute, please see the Town Clerk, or the Deputy Clerk for a copy.

*Access to public records is not without limitations. Certain records must remain confidential by law.
