

Additional information for applicants

- The Harbor Commission is a statutory body that performs duties according to guidelines set out in state law (Chapter 30.37 and 30.38). State law spells out the responsibilities and independent authority of the Commission, the relationship between the Commission and the Town, and where the Commission must obtain authorization from the Town Board.
- Members do not receive any compensation (except for reimbursement of expenses).
- Members will be appointed by the Town Chair and ratified by the Town Board for staggered lengths of service, with terms of up to 3 years.
- Members will set up their own governing rules, set up their own meeting schedule, and oversee at least one employee. They will be subject both to the transparency of open meetings requirements under state statute, and to the confidentiality required, at times, to deal with financial, legal, and personnel matters.
- In addition to residency requirements, applicants must not be delinquent in any Town personal taxes, Town utilities, or other Town assessments, and must not have any claim pending against the Town.
