- 4. Presentation: Mike Halsted from Wisconsin Harbor and Waterways: Introduction of Harbor Assistance Program (HAP) and waterborne commerce. There is 29 HAP eligible ports in the state of Wisconsin. This year 20 million was awarded to fund projects throughout the state not limited to dredging, infrastructure, and development. HAP has already helped fund projects here in La Pointe, including the redevelopment of dock and landing in 2018/19. The \$200,000 awarded to the La Pointe Harbor Commission from the Governor's budget will come from the HAP budget. M. Childers thanks Governor Evers, along with senator Quinn and Representative Green for their support in startup cost funds for the Harbor Commission.
- 5. Presentation: Mary Forlenza from the FHWA: Every state has a federal highway office. It's important to fill out the National Census of Ferry Operators (NCFO) submit to Federal Bureau of Statistics to be eligible for Federal Ferry Boat Program. There is a two-year delay to receive any reward money. To receive federal funding, the operation must be publicly owned. The state DOT works with the FHWA to help facilitate funding and support for publicly owned ferries. There are many eligibilities to use the money such as operating costs, ferry boats terminal facilities, maintenance facilities and the procurement of transit vehicles. There is about 110 billion dollars available nationally, and about 90-92% is awarded. There is a formula used based on ridership, vehicle use, milage, etc. that goes into how the money is allocated.
