- Parks. Public Works requests permission to <u>post the job opening for Camp Host #1 for calendar year 2024</u>, at the budgeted amount of \$18.00/hour, not to exceed 1,000 hours.
- Airport.
 - o Hangar leases. Leases expire Dec. 31 for Theodore Fritsche (#14), L&F Land Management (#1A), and Jon Stevens (#8). The renewal rate would be \$0.624537794160 per year per square foot of hangar, plus annual increases based on the CPI-U. TENTATIVE
 - o Industrial lot lease. The lease expires Dec. 31 for Cedric Teisberg (Lot 6). The renewal rate would be \$941.75 per year, plus annual increases based on the CPI-U. TENTATIVE
- **Greenwood Cemetery.** The current contract with Kathleen Erickson for mowing the cemetery expires on December 31. **TENTATIVE**
- Zoning.
 - o **Fire sign installation.** The Town received two bids: one for \$40 per sign, one for \$28.88 per sign. Staff recommend rejecting both bids and instead planning to install the signs in-house by hiring a seasonal employee. The 2024 budget allocates 800 hours, at \$18/hour, for an estimated rate of \$17.25 per sign.
- Town Hall Administration.
 - Elected officials' salaries. This <u>resolution</u> codifies the staggered increases in elected officials' pay that electors approved at the Town Meeting on April 18, 2023.
 - o **Election inspectors.** This <u>resolution</u> appoints election officials for 2024. There will be four elections in the new year.
 - Fee schedule. This <u>resolution</u> codifies the fees factored into the 2024 budget. You postponed action during the Dec. 5 meeting.
 - Contract with YWS Technologies. The contract with our computer and internet consultant
 expires on Dec. 31. A proposed two-year renewal clarifies language, but does not change rates.
 TENTATIVE
 - o Compensation. This <u>resolution</u> codifies the pay rates and hours factored into the 2024 budget.
- Insurance. This is the annual <u>renewal of the Town's insurance package</u>. You have a 17-page summary in your packet; let me know if you would like the full 66-page proposal.
 - Property, Crime, Inland Marine, Auto, General Liability, Public Officials and Management Liability, Excess Liability, and Workers Compensation are routine renewals with the same carriers. The renewals raise deductibles to \$2,500 for property and to \$1,000 for vehicles.
 - Airport Liability is a routine renewal but with a different carrier; the new policy offers a lower rate than the previous carrier, and locks in that rate for three years.
 - Cyber Liability is now a separate policy; it previously was part of the general liability package. I propose the option with a \$1 million ceiling and \$1,000 deductible.
 - Volunteer Accident and Sickness is a new option that offers disability, medical expense, occupational training, and loss-of-life benefits to the Town's volunteer fire and ambulance members. I propose an option with the \$50,000 loss-of-life benefit; this option would be a new cost \$1,227.

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
- There are two potential motions:
 - o Renew existing coverage for 2024 (including Cyber). Combined premiums total \$122,510, or 3.8 percent less than 2023 premiums, which were \$127,364. (The reduction is the result of lower workers' compensation premiums.)
 - o Add a Volunteer Accident and Sickness policy.
- o **Premier resort tax.** During budget discussions, Town Board members expressed interest in seeking legislative approval for such a sales tax in La Pointe. This agenda item seeks further discussion on authorizing staff, Board members, or others to begin pursuing conversation with local legislators and stakeholders. The memo I originally wrote on Oct. 31 is in your packet.

Police.

Ordinance Chapter 42.34. The existing ordinance bans parking on the west side of Whitefish Street for its entirety. However, the Town is unable to enforce the ban between Big Bay Road and Col. Woods Ave. for two reasons: There is not enough right-of-way on that side of the street to place signs at the beginning of the "no parking" zone, and the adjacent landowner will not grant permission to place signs on private property. The proposed amendment recognizes that reality; the change would allow anyone to park on the west side of Whitefish except for the hours of 2:30 a.m.-5:30 a.m.

Fire.

O Contract with Big Water Fire Apparatus. The current contract for basic maintenance of fire and ambulance vehicles expires on Dec. 31. The proposed renewal is for calendar year 2024. The maximum payment is based on what the two departments have budgeted for vehicle maintenance. TENTATIVE

Re: Premier resort area

State statute 66.1113 allows communities to declare themselves a premier resort area if at least 40% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property within the community is used by tourism-related retailers. The legislation defines 21 categories of retailers that qualify. In La Pointe, retailers might qualify under the categories of miscellaneous and general merchandise stores; retail bakeries; eating places; drinking places; liquor stores; sporting goods stores and bicycle shops; gift, novelty and souvenir shops, hotels and motels, public golf courses, and amusement and recreational services, not elsewhere classified.

Communities that qualify are able to enact a sales tax of 0.5% on an even larger list of retailers. Based on state statistics for 2022, a local sales tax could have generated roughly \$45,000 for La Pointe, assuming the tax could have been applied to all retail activity.

It is unlikely that La Pointe would qualify under the statutory formula, however. The state calculates the equalized value in La Pointe in 2023 at \$385,743,300. That would require the equalized value of tourism-related retailers to exceed \$154,297,320, which is a high bar to clear.

A more likely path for La Pointe would be to seek special legislation allowing the Town to declare itself a premier resort area. This has worked for six other communities: Bayfield, Eagle River, Ephraim, Rhinelander, Sister Bay, and Stockholm. (However, be aware that all these communities are cities or villages; no town is among the exceptions allowed in statute.) Typically, this path requires the legislation clearing the Assembly, Senate and Governor's Office; the Town Board adopting a resolution of its intent to impose the tax; and electors approving the resolution through a referendum held during a statewide election at least 70 days after the Town Board's action.

Other Crime coverages include Forgery or Alteration, Money & Securities, Computer and Funds Transfer Fraud, Money Orders and Counterfeit Paper Currency, and Fraudulent Impersonation.

Coverage does not apply to any public officials or employees whose positions require separate bonds such as a tax collector or treasurer. Those obligations are typically addressed by a surety bond and Glatfelter Public Entities coverage cannot be used to fulfill those requirements.




