

VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT

SPRING ELECTION

APRIL 7th, 2026

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may submit a request to vote absentee ballot to their municipal clerk. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in a ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 28 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

You must make a request for an absentee ballot in writing or online at MyVote.wi.gov

Contact your municipal clerk and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the election. You may also submit a written request in the form of a letter, or you may apply for an absentee ballot online at MyVote.wi.gov. Your written request must list your voting address within the municipality in which you vote, where the absentee ballot should be sent, and your signature. You may apply for an absentee ballot with your municipal clerk in person, by mail, fax, email, or at MyVote.wi.gov.

Registration to receive an Absentee Ballot

The deadline to register to receive an absentee ballot is:

5:00pm on April 2nd, 2026

Note: Special absentee voting applications may apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

Voting by Absentee Ballot in person

You can also personally go into the clerk's office and vote by absentee ballot within the following dates:

First day to vote (early in person) by absentee in the Clerk's office: March 24th 2026

Last day to vote (early in person) by absentee in the Clerk's office: April 3rd, 2026

No in person absentee voting may occur the day before an election.

THE MUNICIPAL CLERK WILL DELIVER VOTED BALLOTS RETURNED ON OR BEFORE ELECTION DAY TO THE PROPER POLLING PLACES BEFORE THE POLLS CLOSE ON APRIL 7th, 2026. ANY RECEIVED AFTER THE POLLS CLOSE WILL NOT BE COUNTED.
